


From the West:

Take the Indiana Toll Road East to Exit 72, US 31 South. Follow it as it becomes the US 20 Bypass. Exit south onto State Road 19. In approximately 6½ miles turn left onto County Road 40. Southwest Bible Church is approximately 3 miles east on left-hand side.

From the East:

Take the Indiana Toll Road West to Exit 101 in Bristol. Take State Road 15 South through Goshen. Turn right onto Plymouth Street and follow State Road 119 to County Road 40. Turn right. Southwest Bible Church is approximately 1/8 of a mile west on right-hand side.

Note: Due to road construction, it's best to avoid State Road 19 in Elkhart north of US 33.



From the South:

From US 31 North, take the US 20 Bypass East. Exit south onto State Road 19. In approximately 6½ miles, turn left onto County Road 40. Southwest Bible Church is approximately 3 miles east on left-hand side.

Driving Directions: We will post signs on campus to help you find Wesley Foundation; it's just past the Fetzer Center.

- From US-131 (from Goshen): at exit #36A turn east onto Stadium Drive. Go 2 miles and turn left onto Howard Street. At the next light turn right onto Michigan Ave, follow the roundabout onto Rankin Ave and follow signs to Wesley Foundation, just beyond the Fetzer Center, and on the right.
- I-94 (from Chicago) at exit #74b turn north onto US-131, and follow the above directions.
- I-94 (from Detroit) at exit #82, follow the Business Loop through to downtown Kalamazoo on King Highway, Kalamazoo Ave and Stadium Drive. Turn right on Howard. Turn right on Michigan Ave. and follow roundabout onto Rankin Ave, follow signs to Wesley Foundation.
- M-43 (W. Main): turn south onto Solon (one-way southbound) which becomes Howard St. Turn left at the light onto Michigan Ave, follow the roundabout onto Rankin as above.

Motel: The Red Roof Inn, located at 5425 West Michigan Avenue, Kalamazoo, is holding non-smoking two double bed rooms for \$59.49 or \$63.74 for 2 people. Call 269-375-7400 and ask for the reserved group B025SAHARP by July 13. They provide coffee, but no breakfast. There are many restaurants on Stadium Drive, on the way to the singing. There will be coffee, fruit and cookies at the singing. Directions: From US-131 turn at Exit 36b. Turn right at first light, 11th Street, then right on West Michigan. Motel will be on the right. Please make your overnight plans as soon as possible.

Directions from the Red Roof Inn to Wesley Foundation: Turn left out of the motel parking lot onto Michigan Avenue, then left again onto 11th Street. Turn left at the light onto Stadium Drive. Take it to Howard Street and get into the left turn lane. You will see a big brick wall announcing Western Michigan University. Turn left onto Howard Street to the first light and turn right onto Michigan Avenue. Go around the roundabout, essentially making a left turn onto Rankin. Continue to Business Court, turn right and follow signs to Wesley Foundation.
